## GUIDELINES FOR BRAZORIA-GALVESTON COUNTY FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP 2026

- I. The Scholarship Committee of Brazoria-Galveston County Farm Bureau will select an individual to receive a \$4,000 scholarship.
- II. To be eligible to receive the scholarship, an applicant must:
  - a. Be a graduating high school senior from a Brazoria or Galveston County high school, a Clear Creek ISD high school or a home school student residing in Brazoria or Galveston County.
  - b. Turn in completed application form accompanied by a high school transcript, SAT and/or ACT test results (if applicable) and three (3) letters of reference.
  - c. Plan to attend a college, technical or trade school and take a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester. (Will be required to provide proof of registration.)
  - d. Be the son or daughter of a current **Brazoria-Galveston County Farm Bureau** member. If awarded, parents must maintain membership for the duration of the scholarship.
  - e. Submit application no later than March 23, 2026.
- III. The money will be paid directly to the college/school as follows:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Year- \$500 the fall semester upon proof of registration for a minimum of 12 credit hours. \$500 the spring semester, upon proof of registration for a minimum of 12 credit hours and a minimum 2.0 GPA maintained the preceding semester.
  - **2<sup>nd</sup> Year-** \$500 the fall semester and \$500 the spring semester with registration for 12 credit hours minimum and minimum **2.0** GPA the preceding semester.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Year- \$500 the fall semester and \$500 the spring semester with registration for 12 credit hours minimum and minimum 2.0 GPA the preceding semester.
  - 4<sup>th</sup> Year-\$500 the fall semester and \$500 the spring semester with registration for 12 credit hours minimum and a minimum 2.0 GPA the preceding semester.

    Scholarship stops if at any time the requirements for a semester are not met.
